Three Types of People

In something I was reading, this paragraph stood out.

Never forget that in your life are three types of people.

1. People who helped you in your difficult times

2. People who left you in your difficult times

3. People who put you in your difficult times

There are at least two points that can be made from this assessment. First, there are all sorts of people and behavior issues with whom you have contact. Some behavior can be controlled by outside forces. An example of this is drivers slowing down when they know a traffic cop is present. In society and in church, people sometimes modify their behavior because of "the law." Legalism cannot change the heart, only the Holy Spirit can do that. Second, a take away from that paragraph is that you are not responsible for the behavior of others. It is not a trite statement to say each of us will answer to God for our behavior. If you have had to deal with un-Christ-like behavior on the part of others, remember that you cannot change them, only God can. Also remember that they are accountable to God for their behavior, not to you.
