
## **Not All Things Change**

## La Esperanza Church

In November 2015 La Esperanza Baptist church began to pray about what future plans God had for our church. We had been meeting in the homes of various church members. It was becoming hard to keep everyone up to date on where the service would be each week. Some long-time members had stopped attending. It was hard to see what God could do with our situation.

When we had given up finding a local church where we could meet and exhausted possibilities of renting a building, one of our church members called to say God had been leading him to donate part of his land to build a church.

We did not have any idea that He would lead us to build a church building, because we only had around \$1000 in the bank at that time. But, as we know, His ways are higher than ours.

The church currently meets in the garage of one of our members. It has been a blessing to use this location, but there is not much room for growth.

Last fall we began raising funds to construct a building on the donated property. We are blessed to have church members with all of the skills required to build a building, so we only need to raise money for materials. We have shared the vision for the construction project with several churches in the Piedmont Association. As of August 10, the Lord has provided about \$49,000 toward our goal of \$85,000 through the donations of many churches and individuals.

We have begun the process of applying for permits to build. We ask that you pray for our church during this time, because this process is complicated. We are ready to break ground as soon as we receive all of the permits. Please pray specifically for our driveway easement, which has been in process since the beginning of June.

We are always ready to share our story with any church that would like to partner with us in this ministry. Thank you so much for your prayers and support!
