By now each church should have received login instruction for using Sampson Resource material. For many years, the PBA loaned kits to our churches, including women's studies,



Are We Obedient?

I read a testimony yesterday from a young lady from one of our churches that is participating in an 11 month/11 country mission trip around the world. For the last month they

have been serving in Cambodia. Early in the month they met an elderly lady who was blind. Throughout the month the story of Jesus spitting in the dirt and putting mud pies on the eyes of the blind man was a story none of the team could escape. Finally, after much prayer, last week they mustered up the courage to tell the lady about this Bible story and shared they felt God leading them to do the same to her eyes. They shared that they wanted to be obedient to Christ no matter the outcome. She gave them permission and the team spit in the mud and rubbed it on this lady's eyes. Scared and excited, they took some water and washed off the mud.... But the lady still couldn't see! At first the team was disappointed, however, the lady wanted to know more about Jesus. When they shared about Him and what He did for us on the cross, she placed her faith and trust in Him for salvation. Instead of finding SIGHT she found LIFE!!

How often are we given the opportunity to be obedient, even when it sounds crazy, and yet we let it pass us by. It might not be putting mud pies on someone's eyes. It might just be listening and sharing Jesus at the appropriate time. May we spend 2018 arming ourselves with the mind of Christ and being obedient to His Spirit. He may use us to bring someone from death to life.
