can relate to some words he spoke. It was a question he asked God. "How long, oh Lord, how long?" For two years we have faced the awful pandemic of COVID. It has affected families, businesses churches, and every level of society. 2021 - 2022 is the year of "The ComeBack!" I have been asking churches and families to intensify their prayer life. Develop a prayer ministry and strategy. Devote a specific period of time to intensive, intentional prayer. One church has experienced a "40 days of prayer" and another church has done a "100 days of prayer" when teams are praying every day for specific requests.

<u>Come Back to Christ</u> - It is great when those who have strayed from God "come back" to Him.

Come Back to Church - Sadly, many of our PBA churches are still considerably lower in about every category than they were before COVID. The PBA wants to encourage churches with resources and strategies to "re-reach" those who have "dropped out" of church.

Come Back to Evangelism - Next year, 2022, is the year for simultaneous revivals across the association and an Evangelistic Rally on October 2, 2022. The Rally will be on Sunday afternoon and I am asking that each church, each youth ministry, and each family participate in the one-day outdoor event. Attend the rally, bring your "one's", and others who are without Christ. Help them to be in a place where they will hear the Gospel and have an opportunity to come to Christ.

This year and next year can be an exciting time in this area!
