It is hard to believe it is already 2022. For many people and churches, the past few years have been described as crazy, horrible, unpredictable, and various other choice words.

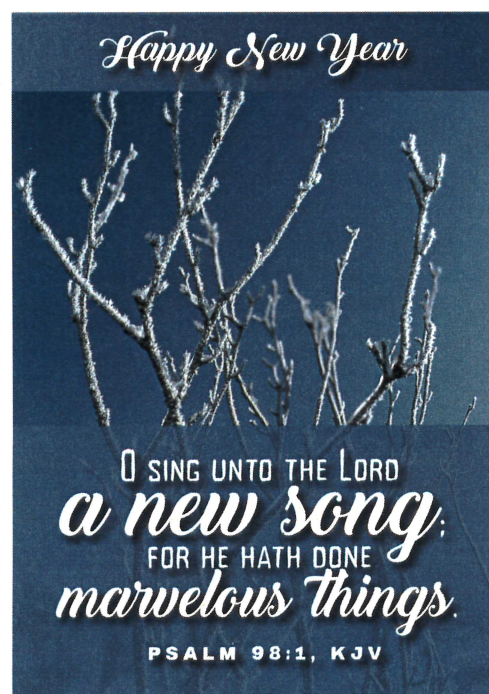
