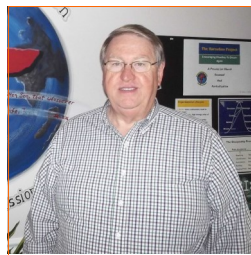

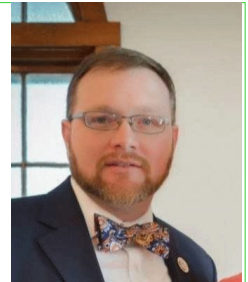
"The harvest is past, the summer is ended, And we are not saved." Jeremiah 8:20
